## **Middle School Academic Requirements 2009-2010 TEA-UIL Side by Side**

### **Eligibility for UIL Participants for the First Six Weeks**

UIL participants are eligible to participate in a contest during the first six weeks of the school year provided the following standards been met:

Students beginning grades nine and below must have been promoted from a lower grade prior to the beginning of the current school year.

If a student has been placed in the next higher grade, rather than promoted, due to inability to achieve at the level required for promotion, he or she is not eligible to participate in extra curricular activities.

State Board of Education Rule 19 TAC 97.113 states that a seventh, eighth, or ninth grade student must have been promoted In order to participate in extracurricular activities at the beginning of the school year. Placement in a grade is not equivalent to promotion.
