Qualifications: All nominations for the Leaders and Achievers Scholarship Program are made exclusively by your High School Principal or Guidance Counselor. Principals and home-school instructors may e-mail comcast@applyists.com to verify school eligibility status and to request program materials. Scholarship materials are not available through any Comcast office or The Comcast Foundation, and the Scholarship Program Administrators will ONLY accept applications submitted by a High School Principal or Guidance Counselor from eligible schools. Interested students should contact their High School Principal or Guidance Counselor to request participation in the Leaders and Achievers Scholarship Program. Your High School Principal or Guidance Counselor may e-mail comcast@applyists.com to verify school eligibility status and to request program materials. If you are a qualified senior attending high school in an eligible community served by Comcast, you can be nominated by your Principal for a Leaders and Achievers scholarship. Each principal may nominate **one** student from an eligible school to be considered for a Leaders and Achievers Scholarship. All scholarship recipients are notified at the end of February each year. Employees of Comcast, its subsidiaries and affiliates, and their families are not eligible.

- Full-time high school senior currently enrolled at a high school within a Comcast Community.
- Student grade point average of 2.8 or higher.
- Student demonstrates leadership abilities in school activities or through work experiences.
- Student shows a strong commitment to and involvement in community service.
- Student plans to attend an accredited, nonprofit college, university, or vocational/technical school in the United States.
- Student will need to verify nomination by entering the Comcast School Code (CSC), provided by the principal or guidance counselor.

- Student will need to complete and approve the terms and conditions set forth in the media release included as part of the scholarship acceptance form. If the nominee is not over the age of eighteen, the parent/guardian must complete and approve the terms and conditions set forth in the media release included as part of the scholarship acceptance form.

- Please review the requirements above and select the best nominee to represent your school.
- **Nominate only one senior.** Multiple applicants will result in disqualification of all entries from your school.
- **The Comcast School Code (CSC) you are to provide to your nominee** is accessible via <https://aim.applyists.net/Comcast/Highschools>. The Comcast School Code website is for exclusive use by school administrators and should not be accessed by students.
- **Please provide the linked document entitled, “ [Nominee Letter](#),” to your nominee.** Please enter the **Comcast School Code (CSC)** on the Nominee Letter.
- After the student completes the online application, the student will provide you with instructions for the online Nomination Certification which you must complete.
- Follow up with your nominee to ensure all online application requirements are submitted by **December 9, 2011. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.**
