Qualifications: The scholarship is designed to enhance recruitment and retention of academically talented undergraduate students from ethnic groups that are typically underrepresented on Mizzou's campus. High school seniors with a minimum ACT composite score of 25 (1130 SAT critical reading and math) are eligible to apply. Selected candidates will be invited to campus to interview for final selection. To retain the scholarship, students must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA for a minimum of 24 hours of graded course work each academic year. Students must be continuously enrolled at Mizzou and participate in MAP, a retention program that helps ensure academic success. Essays and applications should be mailed or faxed by January 1, 2010.

Other Documents Needed: Interested applicants should apply for admission to MU and complete the MU freshman departmental scholarship application form. There is no separate application for the George C. Brooks Scholarship. Applicants who meet the criteria for this scholarship will be asked to submit a typed, one-page essay answering the question: *What long-term effects will diversity in college education have on American society?* Early submission is suggested.
