Qualifications: Vary based on individual scholarship.

Mizzou Heritage Scholarship

Minimum qualifications:

- Student whose biological or adoptive parent graduated from the University of Missouri-Columbia
- Top 25 percent of high school graduating class.
- Composite ACT score of 27 or above (or a combined critical reading and math SAT score of 1210 or above).
- U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident.
- Non-Missouri resident.
- Enroll at MU the first semester after high school graduation.

Award amount: 100% nonresident tuition waiver.

May be canceled or reduced if nonresident tuition is waived or paid by another source.

Application procedure: No application required as you are automatically considered once you are admitted to MU.

Mark Twain Nonresident

Minimum qualifications:

- Top 25 percent of high school graduating class.
- Composite ACT score of 27 or above (or a combined critical reading and math SAT score of 1210 or above).
- U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident.
- Non-Missouri resident.
- Enroll at MU the first semester after high school graduation.

Award amount: Varies according to scores:

Composite ACT 27-29 (or a combined critical reading and math SAT score of 1210-1320)= \$4,000 per year.

Composite ACT 30-36 (or a combined critical reading and math SAT score of 1330-1600)= \$5,500 per year.

May be canceled or reduced if nonresident tuition is waived or paid by another source.

Application procedure: No application required as you are automatically considered once you are admitted to MU.

National Merit

- \$1000-\$2000 per year plus out-of-state fee waiver
- Finalists must designate MU “first choice” with National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC)
