
















4th Nine Weeks

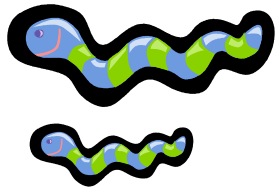
heavier than/lighter than



Heavier than is weighing more. **Lighter than** is weighing less.

The elephant is **heavier than** the deer. The deer is **lighter than** the elephant.

longer/shorter



Longer is something that measures more in length. **Shorter** is something that measures less in length.

The car was **longer** than the bike. The bike was **shorter** than the house.
