














# Kindergarten Science Vocabulary





1<sup>st</sup> Nine Weeks

Vocabulary Word	Picture	Definition	Sentence
<b>sort</b>		<b>Sort</b> is to put a group of things together that are alike in some way.	The student will <b>sort</b> the frogs.
<b>rain</b>		<b>Rain</b> is drops of water that fall to the ground from clouds.	Please close the window so the <b>rain</b> doesn't come in.
<b>cloud</b>		A <b>cloud</b> looks like a white or gray shape floating in the sky.	Rain and snow fall to the earth from the <b>clouds</b> .
<b>senses</b>		Seeing, hearing, tasting, smelling, and touching	We use our <b>senses</b> to help us learn.




## 2<sup>nd</sup> Nine Weeks

<b>living</b>		<b>Living</b> is to be alive.	The insect is <b>living</b> .
<b>non-living</b>		<b>Non-living</b> is to not be alive.	The car is <b>non-living</b> .
<b>sequence</b>		<b>Sequence</b> is the order things follow one another.	He was asked to put the pictures in a <b>sequence</b> .
<b>order</b>		<b>Order</b> means everything is in the right place.	I can say all 26 letters of the alphabet in <b>order</b> .
<b>night</b>		<b>Night</b> is the time that starts when the sun goes down and ends when the sun rises.	Raccoons search for food at <b>night</b> .

<b>day</b>		<b>Day</b> is the time that starts when the sun comes up and ends when the sun goes down.	We played outside all <b>day</b> long.
<b>season</b>		<b>Season</b> means a time of year with its own kind of weather. (spring, summer, fall, and winter)	The four <b>seasons</b> are spring, summer, fall, and winter.
<b>3<sup>rd</sup> Nine Weeks</b>			
<b>measure</b>		To <b>measure</b> is to find out what size something is.	The nurse will <b>measure</b> me at the doctor's office.
<b>compare</b>		<b>Compare</b> is to look at two or more things to find out how they are alike or different.	We can <b>compare</b> the two cars before we buy one.

<p><b>observe</b></p>		<p><b>Observe</b> is to see, watch, or notice.</p>	<p>I will <b>observe</b> the weather.</p>
<p><b>record</b></p>		<p>To <b>record</b> means to write down facts.</p>	<p>Betty will <b>record</b> facts about the frog.</p>
<p><b>describe</b></p>		<p>When you <b>describe</b> something, you tell about it so that someone else will know what it is like.</p>	<p>Renee' will <b>describe</b> her drawing to the class.</p>
<p><b>object</b></p>		<p>An <b>object</b> is a thing that can be touched.</p>	<p>The brown <b>object</b> is a tree.</p>

## 4<sup>th</sup> Nine Weeks

<b>rock</b>		A <b>rock</b> is a broken piece of stone.	I found a <b>rock</b> in the garden.
<b>life cycle</b>		<b>Life cycle</b> is the set of stages and changes in the development of an animal or plant.	The <b>life cycle</b> of a frog starts with an egg.
<b>soil</b>		<b>Soil</b> is the earth in which plants grow.	I put a seed in the <b>soil</b> and watched the plant grow.
