SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. A teaching scholarship will be awarded in May to a CFISD high school senior who plans to pursue an education degree in Health, Physical Education, Recreation or Dance. The applicant must be planning on pursuing a **major in education in one of the following areas**: Health Education, Physical Education, Recreation or Dance. (*Ex. Pre-med, physical therapy, and nursing majors **do not** qualify for this scholarship.*) This grant is awarded by the Cypress-Fairbanks H.O.P.E. Association.
2. The criteria used to select the finalist will include economic necessity, scholarship and leadership. In addition, the applicant must pursue a major in Health Education, Physical Education, Recreation or Dance.
3. The completed application should be mailed to the address at the top of the application and should be returned **no later than March 27, 2009**.
4. The recipient of the H.O.P.E. scholarship will be notified in advance and recognized at their high school awards night. On that night, the recipient will receive written instructions about receiving the scholarship money. The recipient must make use of this scholarship during the fall semester after receiving this award.
