Welcome to PTRX!

Dear Cypress-Fairbanks ISD Employee:

Welcome to PTRX! As an Employee enrolled in the Cypress-Fairbanks Independent School District sponsored medical plan, your prescription drug benefits are provided through PTRX. This will give you a tremendous opportunity to save time and money.

Enclosed are your new PTRX prescription benefit identification cards. PTRX provides two ID cards per household. If you need additional ID cards, complete the enclosed form and return it as instructed on the form.

Your prescription co-payment structure will be:

	Retail (30 days)	Mail (90 Days)
Generic	\$10	\$0
Brand	\$30	\$60
Specialty Drugs	N/A	\$30 (30 days)

If you have one-time prescriptions (such as pain pills, antibiotics, cough syrups) just go to your local pharmacy and pay the normal co-pay. We have 56,000 pharmacies in our network, so your nearest pharmacy is very likely in the network. Visit us at www.ptrx.com to find out for sure.

If you have maintenance medications, the two ways you save money are by using Mail Order and by switching to a lower-cost drug. Do both and you're prescriptions could be free! Employees taking prescription **maintenance medications** are required to obtain these through SaveDirectRx.

Switch to a Lower Cost Drug. It's That Simple.

PTRX has identified a list of high-cost brand maintenance medications that have less expensive but equally effective alternatives available, called SaveSmart™ Generics. If you are on one of the brand name medications listed on the enclosed Prescription Savings Opportunities flyer, we might be able to help you and your physician get an alternative and equally effective prescription for free! Here's all you need to do: If you are on one of the high-cost brand drugs listed on the enclosed Prescription Savings Opportunities flyer, contact PTRX Patient Services Center at 877-4MY-PTRX (877-469-7879). With your permission, our team of certified pharmacy technicians in our PTRX Patient Services Center will contact your physician and alert them about the difference in price between the two choices. If your doctor approves the switch, we'll ship you a 90 day supply and your co-pay will be \$0. If your doctor feels you need to remain on the high-cost drug, we'll ship you that medication and you simply pay your normal brand co-pay. It's that easy.

Mail Order Has A Lower Co-pay.

Use our mail order program instead of going to a local pharmacy. This will save you a lot of money.

Class II Controlled Medications are not filled through SaveDirectRx. You can obtain this particular class of medications at your local retail pharmacy for the following copays: Generic: \$10 / Brand: \$30. An example of a Class II medication is one for Attention Deficit Disorder (ADD). If you have any questions regarding filling of Class II medications, please contact PTRX Patient Services at 877-4MY-PTRX (877-469-7879).

SaveDirectRx accepts the following methods of payment: check, check-by-phone, money order, debit card, American Express, Visa, MasterCard, and Discover. **Please note that prescriptions will be shipped upon receipt of payment.**
