

PTRX Specialty Medication List

Specialty medications are defined as high-cost injectable, infused, oral or inhaled drugs for the treatment of severe acute or chronic medical conditions/illnesses, genetic disorders, and/or rare diseases.

Medications on the PTRX *Specialty Medication List* may cost in excess of \$5,000 per year, and/or require special handling.
