

Grade Level: Intermediate

Name of Skill: Appropriate Appearance

Objective/s: TLW identify the steps for the skill of Appropriate Appearance

TLW write a rationale for using this skill.

TLW create a visual representation/comic strip/slide show of this skill being carried out appropriately

Materials: students, paper, writing utensils, magazines, scanner and computer if needed

Procedure

Introduction: Read Bad Hair Day (a Step Into Reading book)

Students will gather pictures from magazines showing appropriate and inappropriate use of this skill. They will then divide paper into 4-8 squares to map out their comic strip.

Skill Steps: 1. Brush your teeth and bathe every day
2. Comb your hair
3. Wear clean clothes that are appropriate for what you will do that day.
4. Use moderate amounts of make-up or fragrance

Discussion: 1. Why is this skill important?
2. When would this skill be used?
3. Describe a situation where someone should have used this skill.
4. What negative consequences could happen to you if you did not use this skill.

Practice/Activity:

Students can use magazine pictures and do a paper/pencil comic strip.

Extended Activity:

They can scan pictures to be used in a slide show, or if they have internet access, they can download pictures to be used in their slide show.. Students will then organize and create a comic strip/slide show of this skill.

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
