SURVEY ADMINISTRATION

- ✘ All CFISD campuses were asked to participate (excluding alternative campuses).
- ✘ Each campus was assigned a Project Safety Liaison who was responsible for the implementation of the survey.
 - + Liaisons assisted selected teachers in securing a computer lab time or use of the Computers on Wheels (COWs).
 - + Selected teachers were asked to have their students complete the survey online.
- ✘ The survey was available online from September 19 to October 7.

SAMPLING METHOD

School Level	Sample
Elementary	6 homeroom teachers randomly chosen (Teacher's homeroom students to complete survey) -3 Fourth grade teachers -3 Fifth grade teachers
Middle	3 Social Studies teachers randomly chosen (All teacher's students to complete survey) -1 Sixth grade teacher -1 Seventh grade teacher -1 Eighth grade teacher
High	5 teachers randomly chosen if the teacher taught at least one of the following courses (All teacher's students to complete survey): -World Geography -World History -US History -US Government

DATA SCREENING

- × Data was screened to ensure the accuracy of results:
 - + Responses with blank campus numbers were excluded (inability to complete campus level reports)
 - + Online responses with blank grade level were excluded (inability to report grade level analysis)
 - + It was noted that for a short period a technological problem did not allow for participants to complete the survey. For the campuses most affected by this problem, an option to collect student data using paper surveys was provided.
- × The total number of participants used for analysis was 17,554 students.
 - + 17,133 (online) and 421 (paper)
