Frequently Asked Questions

Who should attend the career fair?

- We welcome applicants interested in professional, paraeducator and support positions. This is an opportunity for those interested in employment with Cypress-Fairbanks ISD to meet campus administrators and department leaders.

What are the requirements for certified teachers and aspiring teachers to attend the career fair?

- Certified teachers must show a copy (paper or electronic) of their TEA/SBEC or Out-of-State certificate.
- Current student teachers must show a copy (paper or electronic) of their TEA/SBEC content exam scores or university letter of intent.
- ACP applicants must show a copy (paper or electronic) of their ACP Acceptance Letter or Statement of Eligibility.

What are the requirements for other licensed professionals, degreed individuals, those with a high school diploma or GED, and individuals in non-certified trade positions to attend the career fair?

- None

Do I need to register? Is there a fee?

- You are encouraged to register for the career fair at www.cfid.net, but it is not required. Go to the Job Seekers tab, then Job Postings & Online Applications and “apply” to the posted position titled either:
CFISD Career Fair Pre-Registration (Optional) – Teaching Positions or
CFISD Career Fair Pre-Registration (Optional) – Non-Teaching Positions/Other.

- No pre-registration fee is required, but certified and aspiring teacher applicants **must** have proof of certification to attend (See requirement above).

What do I need to bring to the career fair?

- Bring enough photocopies of your resume’ to share with individual campuses/departments. No copies will be made at the career fair.
- Certified teachers must show a copy (paper or electronic) of their TEA/SBEC or Out-of-State certificate.
- Current student teachers must show a copy (paper or electronic) of their TEA/SBEC content exam scores or university letter of intent.
- ACP applicants must show a copy (paper or electronic) of their ACP Acceptance Letter or Statement of Eligibility.

What schools will be at the career fair?

- Every Cypress-Fairbanks ISD campus will be represented at the career fair.
(High schools – 13, Middle schools – 18, Elementary schools – 56, Special campuses – 4)

Do I need an application on file to attend the career fair?

- We strongly encourage all attendees to submit a completed application prior to the career fair via the internet at www.cfisd.net

Will Cypress Fairbanks ISD be interviewing or hiring at the career fair?

- This is a “Meet and Greet” event. Campus or department leaders may choose to interview or make recommendations for hire at a later date.

Is there a dress code?

- Professional dress is strongly recommended.

Should current Cypress-Fairbanks ISD employees attend the career fair?

- The career fair is intended for those interested in employment with Cypress-Fairbanks ISD.
- Certified teachers and paraeducators should follow the district’s transfer process if interested, in a lateral transfer.

Can paraeducators applying as a teacher attend the career fair?

- Yes, CFISD paraeducators interested in a teaching position can attend the career fair.
