ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Provide coverage for all varsity and sub-varsity high school athletic contests on their campus when possible.
2. Serve as a consultant to senior and junior high school coaching staffs on the prevention and management of athletic injuries.
3. Responsible for the care, prevention and rehabilitation of all athletic injuries.
4. Secure team physician(s).
5. Working under the direct supervision of the team physician(s), implement the following:
 - a. management of acute injury or illness to athlete
 - b. rehabilitation procedures
 - c. operation of therapeutic devices and equipment
 - d. application of braces, guards, tape and other devices
 - e. referrals to the physician, health services, or hospital
 - f. maintain medical records on athletes
 - g. coordination of annual athletic physicals.

7. Recruitment, supervision and instruction of student trainers.
8. Provide athletic injury insurance claim forms.
9. Maintain continuing professional education, license and certification.
