



## Message from the Superintendent

Dear Key Communicator:

In accordance with the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines, Harris County Public Health and Environmental Services (HCPHES) has recommended closure of Yeager Elementary effective Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup>. This recommendation was made after HCPHES was notified of laboratory confirmation of swine flu in a Yeager Elementary student.

Yeager Elementary will remain closed until Monday, May 4<sup>th</sup> pending no additional cases as recommended by HCPHES. As a result of the parents' actions and close coordination with the school and their physician, the student has not been in school this week. No additional confirmed or suspected cases have been identified among students or staff at Yeager Elementary for a period of seven days. The student diagnosed with the flu is doing well and has been released to return to school on Monday.
