Dear Parents of Elementary Students:

Cypress-Fairbanks ISD (CFISD) plans to implement a before- and after-school care program at the elementary campuses beginning in the 2010-2011 school year in an effort to utilize our expertise in providing a quality, enriching program for our students and to use our facilities to generate revenue for the district. This program will replace the after-school care programs currently offered by the YMCA and will be staffed with CFISD employees.

We understand many parents are in need of a safe, structured environment for their children and we are excited about the opportunity to provide this service on your child's home elementary campus. The development of the program is underway and we plan to be ready for the children on the first day of the 2010-2011 school year.

This program will support student academic performance, but will not be an extension of the instructional school day.

- After-school care will be provided from the end of the campus day until 6:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Program staff members will be available to help students with their homework.
- Students will be offered a snack, recreational activities, arts and cultural activities.
- Fees have not been established, but will be very competitive with other childcare programs.
- Reduced rates will be available for parents with more than one child participating.
- Reduced rates will be available to CFISD employees.
