CFISD has entered into a partnership with Ambit Energy in order to generate additional revenue for the district. Ambit Energy has designed a program where community organizations such as churches, PTOs and school districts, can raise funds through rebates based on residential customer electricity usage.

Ambit is a state-approved energy provider that offers competitive rates. Recently, *INC* magazine ranked Ambit Energy the fastest-growing company in the U.S. (for revenue growth). Ambit met the qualifying criteria, two of which included having been founded and generating revenue by 2006 and having generated at least \$2 million by 2009.
