To be regularly informed of the most significant issues directly impacting CFISD, residents of Cy-Fair can subscribe to become a Key Communicator by logging on to the district website.

As a Key Communicator, patrons will frequently receive Key Communicator Letters from Dr. David Anthony, superintendent of schools, providing them with the latest information on important issues and challenges that transpire throughout the school year.

This year alone, 31 Key Communicator Letters were sent out electronically via email to Key Communicators, providing them with valuable facts about major events impacting CFISD schools, students, parents and staff. Critical events that occurred this school year included Hurricane Ike, Legislative action on school finance and accountability and the H1N1 Virus (Swine Flu).

With key details made available by the superintendent regarding the critical events that unexpectedly affected the district's normality this year, Key Communicators were instrumental as they demonstrated their support through the dissemination of accurate information and correction of misinformation within their own communities.

The two-way communication between the district and its primary stakeholders divulges the district's transparency in its day-to-day operations, providing the network of Key Communicators with the facts. Once the network of Key Communicators receives the facts, they circulate the information throughout the community without delay.

Key Communicators not only stay informed with up-to-date district news through Key Communicator Letters, but also by regularly visiting the district website at www.cfisd.net and utilizing the available communication services such as podcasts, district publications and CFTV programs.

Super Seniors can trade in their Super Senior cards for one that will last for a lifetime. The Super Senior card program, designed for members of the Cy-Fair

community who are 60 years or older, recognizes the outstanding and ongoing support of the district's senior residents. Residents 60 years or older who have not applied for a card can log on to the district website at www.cfisd.net and fill out an application or go in person to the Communication Office, located at 10300 Jones Road, during regular business hours (8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.). If a Super Senior filled out an application for the 2008-2009 school year, he/she will not need to reapply for the lifetime card. They simply need to go to the Communication Office with their 2008-2009 card to redeem the new card.
