Early voting begins Oct. 19, ends Oct. 30

Early voting for the **Nov. 3 General Election** and the CFISD Trustee Election will begin on Monday, Oct. 19 and run through Friday, Oct. 30.

Held in conjunction with the Harris County General Election, Cy-Fair registered voters have the option to vote early in person or by mail. This will give voters an opportunity to cast an early ballot in person at a location in close proximity to the Cy-Fair area in order to avoid the long lines on Election Day. Additionally, state and federal law requires all early and Election Day polling locations to be physically accessible to voters with disabilities. For this reason, polling sites have curbside voting available; however, voters must call ahead to notify the early voting clerk. If registered voters will not be able to make it to a polling location during early voting or on Election Day, they may vote early by mail if the following reasons apply:

- the voter will be away from his/her county on Election Day and during early voting;
- the voter is ill or disabled;
- the voter is 65 years of age or older on Election Day; or
- the voter is confined in jail, but eligible to vote.

Applications for a ballot-by-mail must be submitted to the early voting clerk before the close of business on Oct. 27. To vote early by mail, an application must be sent by:

- regular mail;
- common or contract carrier; or
- fax (only if you are submitting your application from outside the county).

Eight locations in or in close proximity to the Cy-Fair area are designated places for general early voting in the **Nov. 3 General Election** and the CFISD Trustee Election (*See Early Voting Locations on page 9.*) Registered voters can cast their ballots in person as early as Oct. 19.
