KAHLA DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS

- IDs are a part of dress code. They must be on a lanyard and visible around the neck all day. Students must have their ID badge or a temporary ID wristband to ride the bus.
- Tights, leggings, yoga pants, or spandex must be accompanied by a mid-thigh length or longer top or dress.
- Pants/jeans that have holes above the knee should not reveal skin.
- Shorts/Skirts- should be worn at the waist and be at least mid-thigh.
- No off-the-shoulder shirts or dresses are permitted. No spaghetti straps.
- Clothes must not reveal underclothing, midsection, back, chest, breast, cleavage, or torso. This includes tank tops (basketball or t-shirts).
- Hoodies/beanies/bonnets/do-rags are not permitted to be worn at any time.
- No type of hat or cap is to be worn with the exception of Fridays with a school spirit shirt.
- No sagging pants. Must be worn at the waist.
- Bandanas are not permitted to be worn or carried at school.
- No pajamas, loungewear, or house shoes/slippers (this includes during testing/finals).
- Sunglasses are not permitted in the school building.
- Tattoos-tattoos that are gang-related, offensive, distracting, or that distract from or interfere with the learning environment of the school must always be covered.
- Clothing with visual or written messages that depict drugs, alcohol, tobacco, violence (guns, knives, etc.), profanity, obscenity, or lack of respect for someone's race, gender, or religion is prohibited.
- No blankets are allowed.

Students who are in violation of the dress code will have the option of correcting the violation (this includes contacting their parent/guardian) or being placed in DMC.

Repeat violators will receive additional consequences.
