Lunch Schedule:

- A.M. testers:
 - Students with "A", "B" or "C" lunch will go straight to lunch after testing.
 - Students with "D" lunch will go to class and then lunch.
- P.M. testers:
 - Students with "A" and "B" lunch will follow normal schedule and report to the testing area at 11:30am.
 - Students with "C" or "D" lunch will eat at 11:04 am and report to the testing area at 11:30am.
- Students taking **two exams in one day are encouraged to bring a sack lunch** to eat between exams.

Bring the following items to the exam room:

- Any form of picture ID
- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers). No mechanical pencils permitted.
- Pens with black or dark blue ink
- Biology exam - A simple four-function (with square root) calculator.
- Calculus, Chemistry, Physics, and Statistics - Up to two calculators with the necessary capabilities. Calculators may not be shared with other students during the exam. Visit www.collegeboard.com/ap/calculators to learn more about the calculator policy for each of these exams. Fresh batteries are recommended.
- Physics exam - A ruler or straightedge
- Your social security number for identification purposes for AP score reports (optional).
- A watch without an alarm (optional)

DO NOT bring the following to the exam room:

- Cell phones, smart phones, smartwatches, laptops, tablet computers, portable listening or recording devices such as MP3 players and iPods, cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet or any other electronic or communication devices. If any of these items are brought into the testing room they will be taken up prior to testing.
- Books, compasses, mechanical pencils, colored pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.
- Rulers and straightedges (except as noted above)
- Scratch paper
- Calculators (except as noted above)
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- Watches that beep or have an alarm.
- Clothing with subject-related information.

You are required to arrive on time. Late arrivals will NOT be allowed to test. Students may not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended; do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the exam.

- If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP Exam obligation. **Afternoon exams will go past the end of the school day.** Please make arrangements for all of these obligations accordingly..

REMEMBER:

Get a good night's rest before your exam and eat a nutritious breakfast. You are allowed to bring a snack and beverage for your 10-minute break. It is advisable to bring a sweater in case the room temperature is below your comfort level.

You are required to abide by the policies of College Board and Cypress Falls High School during the exam. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam score. **If you decide not to take an exam, please inform us as soon as possible prior to the test administration.** No refunds will be issued.
