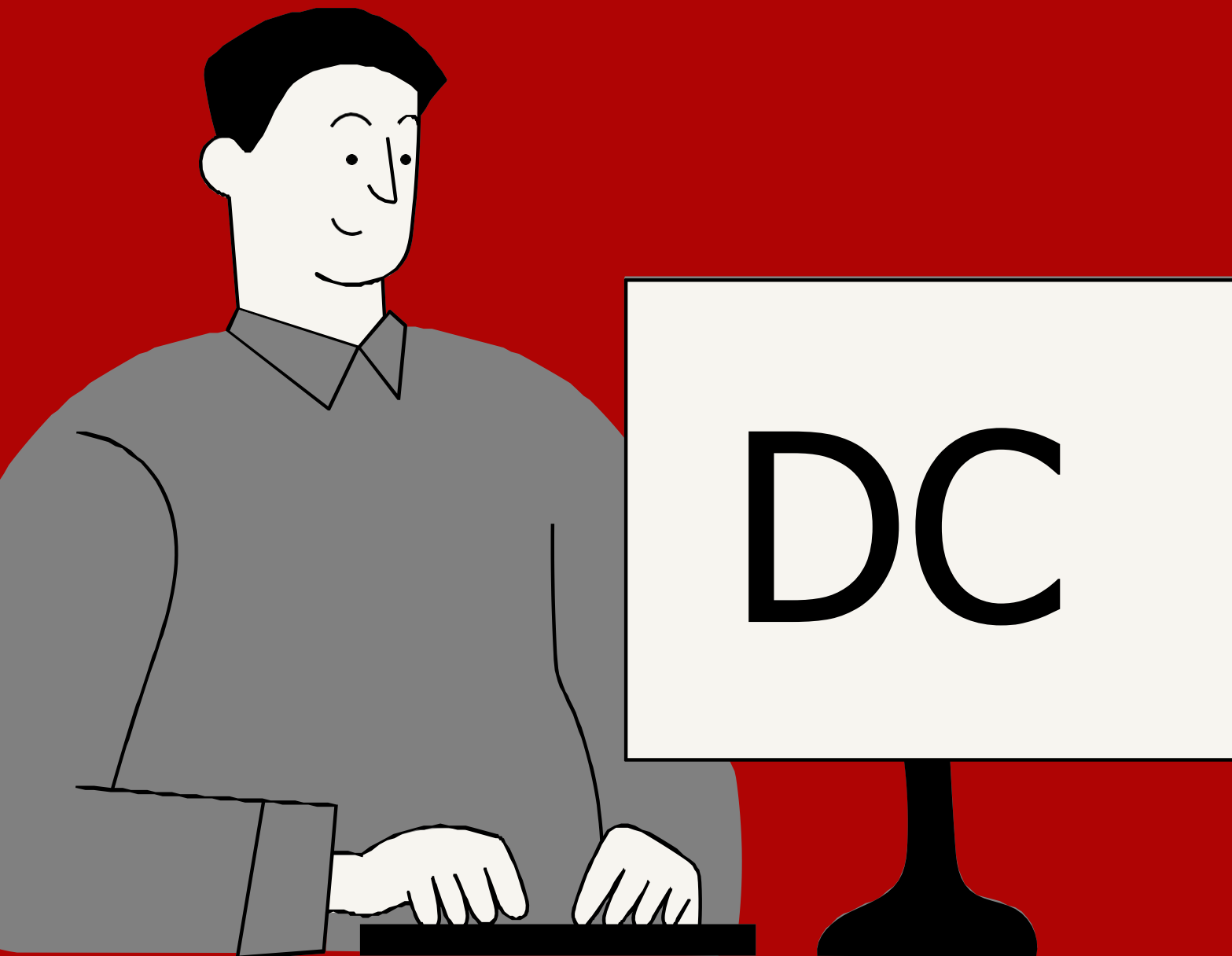

# Advanced Placement

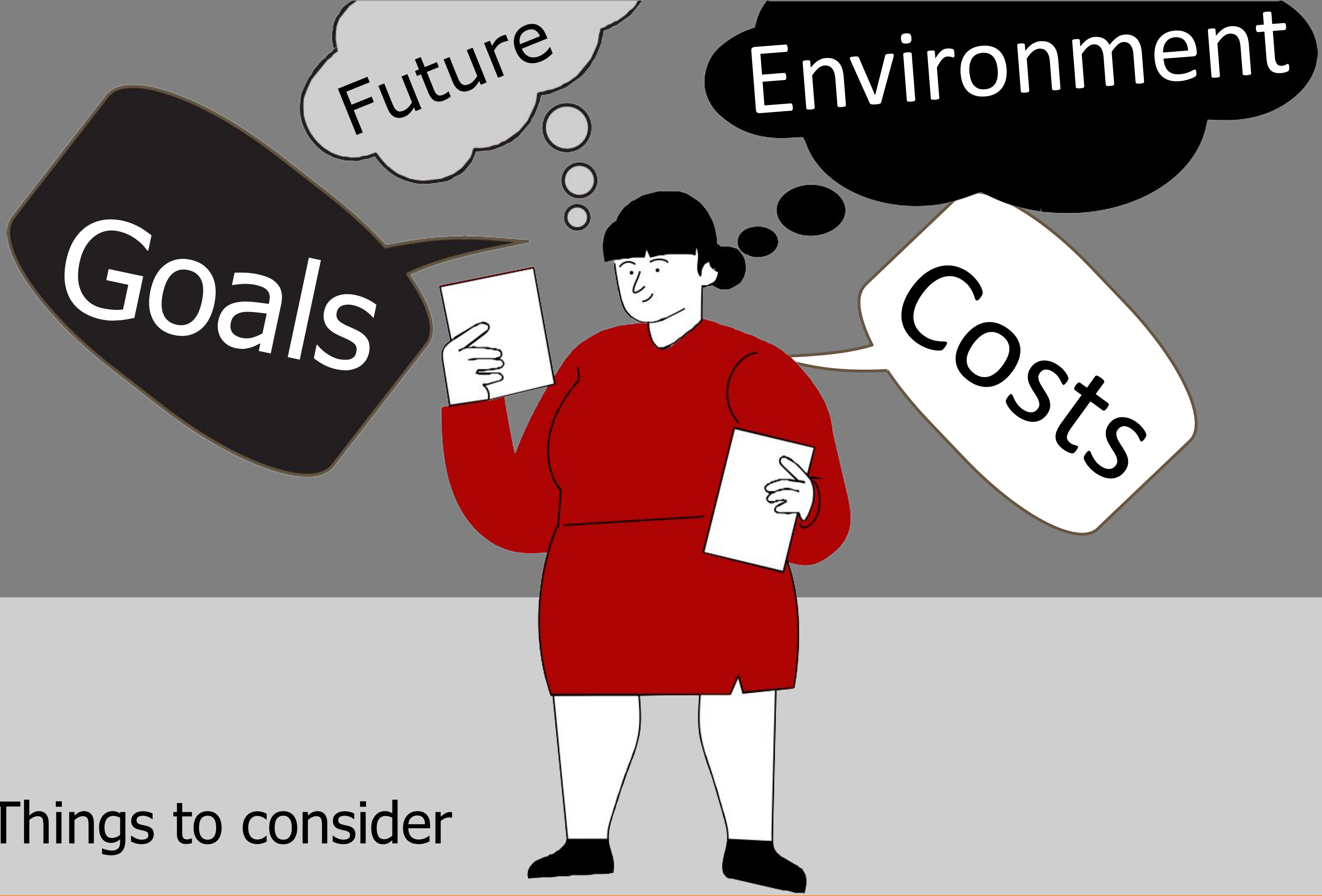


- Classes taken at the high school.
- High school grade on the transcript and GPA.
- College credit through AP test.
- University determines specific credits.
- Only cost is for AP Exam - \$102

# Dual Credit



- Enrolled in both high school and Lone Star College
- Must apply to become a Lone Star College Student
- Grades on both the high school and college transcripts.
- College credit through Lone Star College, then transferred to College
- **Tuition** is waived, **fees** must be paid. (\$120\* - 3 hour course)  
*\* subject to change in May*
