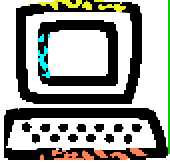

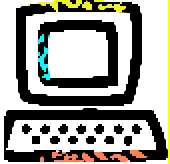
Phonics Express



Phonics Express-Students explore the sounds of our language with games that focus on sound matching, identifying beginning/middle/ending sounds, rhyming, and more.



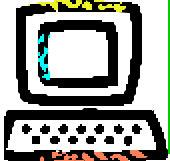
Carnival Countdown- Interactive games that focus on counting, sorting, adding, subtracting, and building patterns and sets. Includes teacher options.

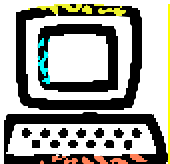
