**STEP 1 – APPLY to LSC by COMPLETING AN ONLINE APPLICATION:** [www.applytexas.org](http://www.applytexas.org) (if needed, directions are located in the CW Counseling Office or on the CW College and Career Site [www.tinvurl.com/cw212college](http://www.tinvurl.com/cw212college) )

### STEP 2 – TEST

STEP 2 - Test (continued)

Students needing to take a TSI will test at LSC and must complete the following:

- A. Have a Lone Star College ID number.
- B. Complete the Pre-Assessment Activity in your MyLoneStar account. (Follow the directions below)
  1. Log into your myLoneStar account.
  2. Click the applicant box.
  3. Click on the "Complete Pre-Assessment Activity" in the blue box.
  4. The Pre-Assessment Activity will take about 25 minutes to complete. Note it will take a few hours for the check to appear on the applicant page of your myLoneStar account.

In order to TSI test ALL students must complete the Pre-Assessment Activity in their mylonestar account.

**\*\*\*LSC will not allow students to TSI test if the pre-assessment activity is not completed.\*\*\***

- C. Obtain a test referral from Ms. Pickett or Mrs. England in the counseling office.
- D. Prep for TSI.

- E. Go to Lone Star College to test. (see back side of referral for dates, times and locations) **WHAT ABOUT TESTING @ WOODS**

- F. Bring a photo ID to the test and the test referral. (CyWoods ID will work)
- G. If retesting, student will pay **\$10 per section**. If testing on Saturday the only way to pay is online. Students either pay in advance or right before test is launched with a credit card. - H. Important: Once TSI testing is complete LSC will give you a copy of your score report. The score report will be turned in with your pink registration form. If you need help determining if you qualify bring the score report to the counseling office and have Ms. Pickett or Mrs. England review your score.

STEP 3 – REGISTER

Complete PINK Registration Form with courses and parent/guardian signatures. Attach scores. (Scores are only necessary if you are new to dual credit classes or if you are now taking a class that has additional test scores criteria.)

**TURN IN PINK Form AND a copy of Test Scores to Ms. Pickett or Mrs. England**

**DUE DATE: April 18, 2019**

STEP 4 - PAY

1. Pay Lone Star College for your Dual Credit Course before the payment deadline. Dual Credit bill typically become available at the beginning of August 2020.
