



- Students may earn more than one endorsement



- <u>STEM</u> Science, Technology (including computer science),
 Engineering, and advanced Math
- <u>Business & Industry</u> Information Technology, database management, marketing, accounting, finance, graphic design, construction, welding, automotive technology, agriculture, hospitality & tourism (culinary arts)
- <u>Public Services</u> Health Science occupations, education, human services (child guidance, cosmetology), AFJROTC
- <u>Arts and Humanities</u> Political science, cultural studies, history, world languages, Fine Arts (Art, Dance, Music, & Theatre)
- <u>Multidisciplinary Studies</u> Provides students the opportunity to take a variety of courses from each of the other four endorsement areas
