



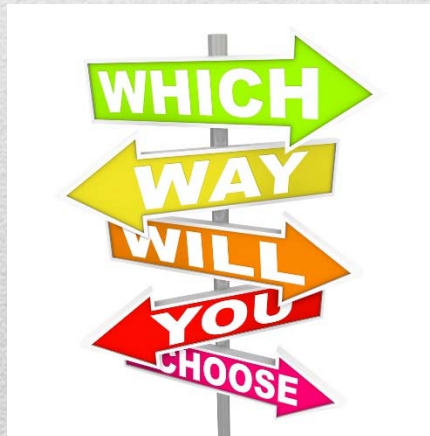
# ***Multidisciplinary Studies***

# *Possible Careers*





❖ 4 English credits

(must include English IV)

❖ 4 Math credits

(must include Algebra I and Geometry)

❖ 4 Science credits

(must include Biology + Chemistry and/or Physics or AP Physics I)

❖ 4 Social Studies credits (must include Geography and/or World History + US History + Government + Economics)

***Option 1: 4 x 4***



❖ **Students take 4 Advanced Placement (AP) or 4 Dual Credit (DC) courses for 4 credits**

(English, Math, Science, Social Studies, LOTE/Foreign Language, & Fine Arts)

**OR**

❖ **Students take a combination of Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Credit (DC) courses for 4 credits**

- Advanced Placement (AP)
  - Earn college credit by taking the AP exam in the Spring
  - Each college or university determines whether or not credit is awarded from their institution
- Dual Credit (DC)
  - Earn high school and college credit for a specific high school course through successful completion of the course
  - **Note: Specific entry requirements must be met before enrolling in DC classes**
