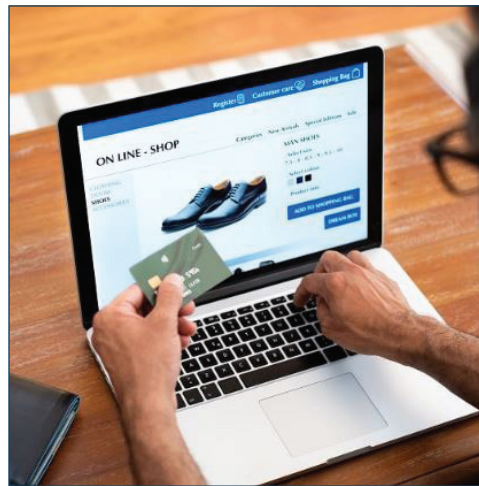

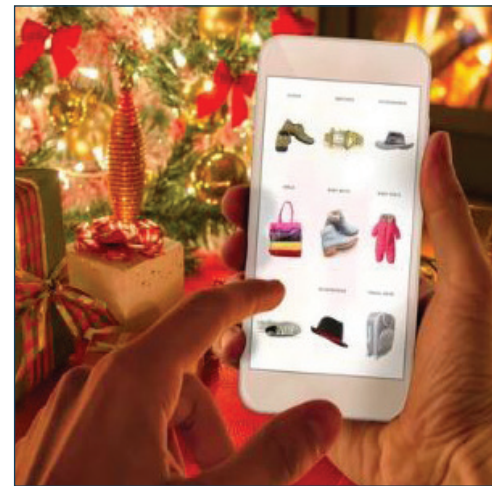

This year, give yourself the gift of peace of mind by following 4 core behaviors: 1) Protect each account with a unique, complex password that is at least 12 characters long. 2) Use multifactor authentication (MFA) for any account that allows it. 3) Turn on automatic software updates, or install updates as soon as they are available. 4) And finally, know how to identify phishing attempts, and report phishing messages to your email program.
