CHANGES IN TRANSPORTATION

End of Day Transportation Procedures

As always, our top priority is the safety and security of our students and staff. Please help us keep your children safe by adhering to our end of day procedures. These procedures are designed to safely and efficiently get your children home each day. One primary means of transportation should be chosen for the year. Changes of transportation should be kept to a minimum and must be in writing. Requirements are established to help guarantee the safety of every student. A change in transportation must be arranged prior to 2:30 pm to allow adequate time for our staff to communicate the change to the appropriate persons. When there is a change from the usual means of transportation, parents must notify the school in writing. All communication should be directed to the homeroom teacher. Written permission for a change in transportation may be faxed, if necessary.

Car Rider Times

A.M. Drop off: 8:20 A.M. - 8:45 A.M.

A.M. Pre-K/PPCD: pick up at 12:00 P.M. (At noon you will pick up in front office)

P.M. Pre-K/PPCD: drop off @ 12:50 P.M.

P.M. pick up: 4:10 P.M. - 4:25 P.M.

- **ALL vehicles must have the appropriate Adam Car Rider tag displayed in the front windshield until the child has been loaded into the vehicle.** Starting the second week of school, students will not be loaded into a vehicle without this tag. Drivers will be asked to go to the front office with identification to take the child.
- **Do not drop your child off before 8:20 AM** - the building is locked and there is no supervision.
- All vehicles enter from Dakar onto Honey Grove traveling east towards Maxim. Turn right into the first parking lot entrance. Traffic will flow in the parking lot and loop back to the same entrance.
- Staff will begin unloading cars at **8:20 AM**.
- Staff will direct you when to unload your student. To ensure a safe and timely arrival process, please have your child ready to unload when asked.
- Children **will be** required to enter and exit from the **passenger-side of their car**. They will then be directed to our sidewalk and will make their way into the building.
- We encourage all children to open their own car doors in the morning.
- **Promptly at 8:45 AM** you will have to go to the front office and sign your student in. **They are tardy at 8:45AM.**
- Do not park in the back and walk your student up to the building.

- During afternoon pick-up, students will be supervised and helped as needed.
- Students must learn the car rider number they are assigned.
- The line for car-riders begins at 4:10 p.m. as that is our end time.
- Students must be picked up by 4:25 PM.
- At 4:25 they will be taken to the front office and you will need to park and go in to the front office and present ID to pick them up. At this time, you will sign them out.
- After the 3rd late pickup you will be contacted by an administrator to discuss possible changes in transportation.
