CHANGES IN TRANSPORTATION

End of Day Transportation Procedures

As always, our top priority is the safety and security of our students and staff. Please help us keep your children safe by adhering to our end of day procedures. These procedures are designed to get your children home each day safely and efficiently. One primary means of transportation should be chosen for the year. Changes of transportation should be kept to a minimum and must be in writing. Requirements are established to help guarantee the safety of every student. A change in transportation must be arranged prior to 2:30 pm to allow adequate time for our staff to communicate the change to the appropriate persons. When there is a change from the usual means of transportation, parents must notify the school in writing. All communication should be directed to the homeroom teacher. Written permission for a change in transportation may be faxed, if necessary.

Our fax number is 281-517-2089. Phone calls to change transportation are not permitted.

Lunch Visitors:

- All lunch visitors must have a valid ID to be scanned.
- Lunch visitors must wear their visitor sticker on their shirt where it is visible.
- Parents/Guardians may only eat with their student.
- If someone besides a parent or guardian would like to eat with a student (grandparent, aunt, uncle, etc), the parent/guardian must send a written note giving permission.
- Students will return to their homeroom table when the lights are turned off during the last few minutes to ensure we have a smooth transition to recess or back to the classroom.
- Parents/guardians may leave when the lights are turned off in the cafeteria and the student returns to their table.

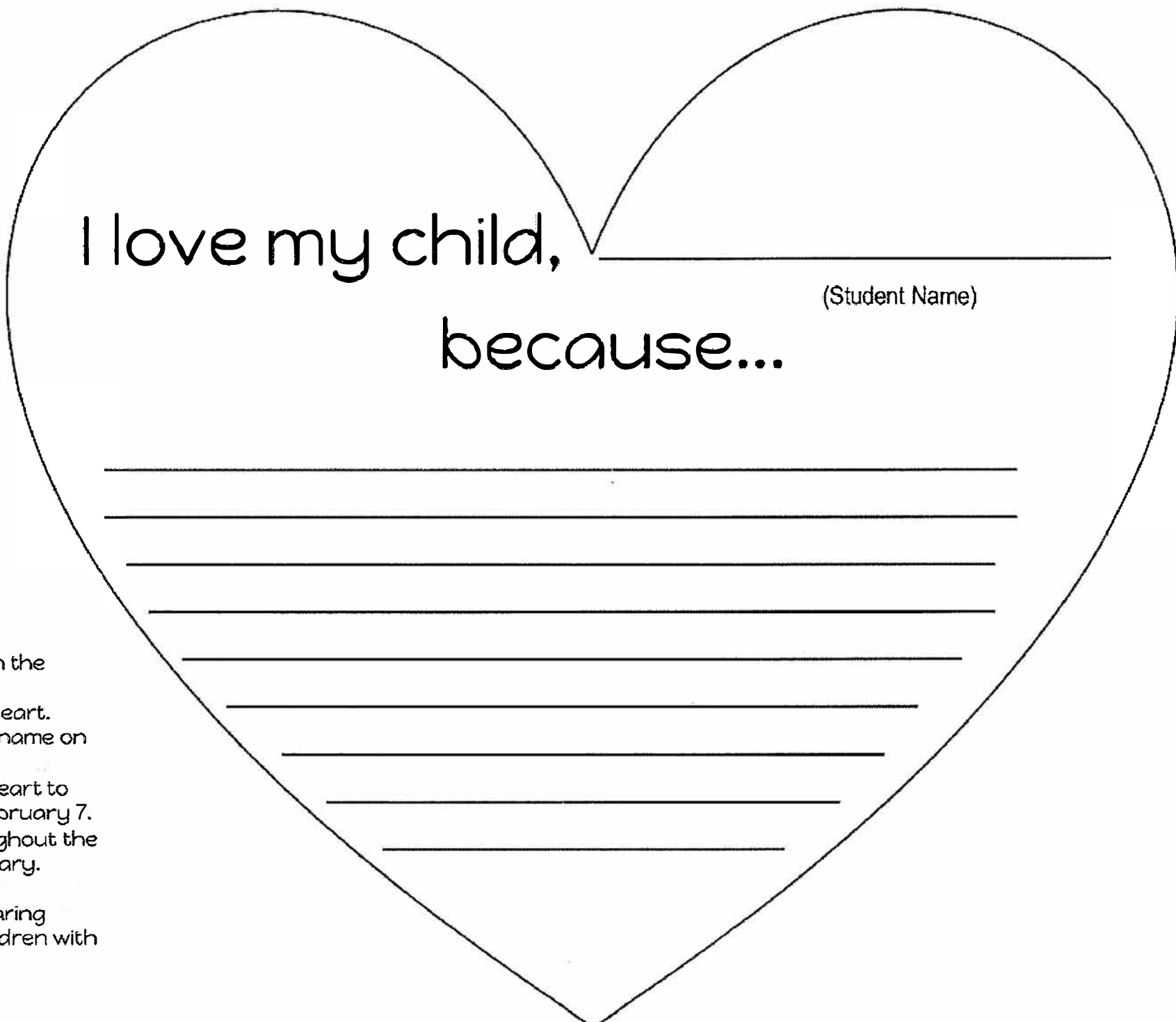
