At Hopper, we pledge to provide a safe and supportive environment where students experience *success* through three areas –Academics, Attendance and Attitude. Together we will build special memories, exploring career paths, and prepare your student for high school.

Important Information



- **Back to School** First day of classes is Monday, August 22nd. Students are expected to be at school by 7:40 a.m. with doors opening at 7:15 a.m. **Student drop off is via Rustic Lake Lane (traffic light).**



- **Transportation** information is available on the Cypress Fairbanks I.S.D. website at www.cfisd.net. Choose **PARENTS & STUDENTS ~ TRANSPORTATION ~ ‘Which Bus Do I Ride?’** Enter your student’s transportation address.



- **Breakfast and Lunch** are provided free of charge to all students. Students wishing to bring a lunch need to follow the bag guidelines established by the district. Lunch guests are not permitted but parent/guardian may drop off lunch at the front desk. Unfortunately, we are NOT able to accept deliveries from friends, relatives or delivery services. Food and/or drink (including water bottles) are not permitted in the classroom. If students have food/drink items for lunch it must remain in the lunch kit/backpack until their designated lunch time.
- **Cell Phones** – Cell phones, electronic devices, headphones/Airpods are not seen during the school day.



- **Student Devices** – Students are required to bring their device to school EVERY day, fully charged.



- **Student ID Badges** - Students must wear their school issued ID badge (free of stickers) on the school provided lanyard at all times. Students are required to purchase a new badge for lost or intentionally damaged badges.

- **Clear Bag Policy** – All students are expected to follow the clear bag policy in place at all secondary campuses in CFISD.
- **Dress Code** - At Hopper Middle School, we do not require a uniform, but rather we encourage students to make professional and appropriate choices from their wardrobes. As you and your child prepare for the upcoming school year, we ask that you review the dress and grooming guidelines together from our Student Handbook. Please pay special attention to the following student guidelines:
 - ✓ Pants – to be worn at waist and must not reveal underclothing or shorts, no frails or holes above knee, no sagging
 - ✓ Leggings/Tights – may be worn only with shirt/dress that is mid-thigh or longer in length
 - ✓ Shorts and Skirts – must be fitted at the waist, not to reveal underclothing, and must be mid-thigh or longer in length
 - ✓ Tops, Shirts, and Blouses – must cover underclothing, midsection, torso, back, chest area
 - ✓ Dresses – must cover underclothing, midsection, torso, back, chest area, and be at least mid-thigh in length
 - ✓ Pajamas/Loungewear/Blankets – keep at home
 - ✓ Head Coverings/Hats/Caps/Bandanas – keep at home
 - ✓ Hooded sweatshirts are allowed but the hood must be down at all times.
 - ✓ Shoes – no athletic slides, house shoes or slippers for safety reasons



We encourage you to check Home Access Center and Schoology regularly to keep up with your student's academics. We Trust that with everyone's best Effort and positive Attitude the Message is clear; at Hopper Middle School it is all about the TEAM. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact the school. We look forward to partnering with you to have a successful academic school year. Working together, as partners, we will keep the "primary goal" in mind – *Success* for all Hopper Huskies.
