Art

- Art I can be taken in any grade 9th – 12th
- Art classes are selected based on a specific area of focus.

- Drawing/Painting
- Sculpture/Ceramics

- Studio 2D (Drawing/Painting)
- Studio 3D (Sculpture/Ceramics)
- Studio Photography
- Studio Digital Art & Media



Music

Band or Band/Color Guard

Band I, II, III, IV

Students new to the CFISD Band program should have playing experience.



or



Band I-CG, II-CG, III-CG, IV-CG (Color Guard)

*Band I or Band I-Color Guard will provide the student with the required graduation credit in **Fine Arts**.
Completion of Band II or Band II-CG will meet the graduation requirement in **P.E.**



Music

Choir

Choir I, II, III, IV

- Choir I can be taken in any grade
9th – 12th



Music Orchestra



Orchestra I, II, III, IV

- Orchestra I can be taken in any grade
9th – 12th

Theatre

Theatre Arts I, II, III, IV

- Acting / Performance



Technical Theatre I, II, III, IV

- Set design/Lighting/Props/Costumes

Theatre Production I, II, III, IV

- Production process as it relates to acting & technical theatre; **Teacher approval required**



FINE ARTS

Dance Team

Dance I (Fine Arts) , Dance Team II, III, IV

- Development of skills, training and performing at events and competitions on the Dance Team (try-outs required)

*Dance I (FA) will provide the student with the required graduation credit in **Fine Arts**. Completion of Dance Team II (PE substitute) will meet the graduation requirement in **P.E.**

Dance

Dance I (Fine Arts), Dance II (PE), III, IV

- Development of skills in a variety of dance techniques

*Dance I (FA) will provide the student with the required graduation credit in **Fine Arts**. Completion of Dance II (PE) will meet the graduation requirement in **P.E.**

Students taking at least two years of Dance Team or Dance, should schedule the Fine Art credit course as Course I and the PE credit course as Course II

Examples:

Dance I (FA), Dance Team II (PE sub), Dance Team III, Dance Team IV
or
Dance I (FA), Dance II (PE), Dance III, Dance IV
