

District of Innovation



During the October 2023 board meeting, our board approved the district moving forward to develop a proposed District of Innovation (DOI) Plan. The board also approved the Districtwide Educational Improvement Council

(DEIC) to serve as the DOI Planning Committee.

The committee met once in October and twice in November. A proposed plan was developed and is now posted for review for 30 days on the CFISD website. The next step is for the DEIC to vote to approve (majority) or not approve the plan on December 14. If approved, the plan will be sent to the board in January 2024 for a vote (2/3 majority to approve.)

Honor roll

Students in grades $2^{nd} - 5^{th}$ are eligible for honor roll. To earn honor



roll students must receive all A's or a combination of more A's than B's on the report card. In addition, students must maintain all S's in conduct and work habits.

Our overall school attendance rate is an indicator on our state accountability rating and effects Warner's overall success. Students arriving after 8:15 a.m. are tardy. Attendance is marked daily at 9:30 a.m. Students who are absent should

submit a written excuse (parent note or doctor's excuse) upon returning to school or you may email it to Warner@cfisd.net. Excessive tardies/absences will be referred to the district's truancy officer.

Note: Due to district policy, we are **NOT** allowed to accept emails as excuse notes. We must have a Doctor Note or Signed Note from a parent. You may scan a signed written note or doctor note to warner@cfisd.net.
