Parents/Guardians may bring food and

beverages for their child, but they <u>may not</u> bring food/drinks for other children. Many parents/guardians treat their children to special lunches from outside restaurants occasionally. While we encourage you to reward your children with these special celebrations, we ask that if you are bringing your child lunch that you arrive on time. To protect instructional time, any student waiting on a parent/guardian ten minutes after lunch has begun will be sent through the cafeteria line.

News from the Cafeteria



To determine eligibility for free or reduced-price meals for the 2023-2024 school year, families with students who do not attend a Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) campus will need to

complete a Free & Reduced Meal Application. Applications must be completed each school year to determine eligibility.

View the <u>U.S. Department of Agriculture's Child Nutrition Programs Income Eligibility Guidelines</u>. The Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) administers school nutrition programs in Texas and offers an eligibility calculator on the <u>Square Meals Online Program Eligibility Form.</u>

Please note that students who are attending a USDA designated Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) campus during the 2023-2024 school year will receive free meals and are not required to complete a Free and Reduced Meal Application. Information about the USDA CEP program and eligible Cy-Fair ISD campuses is posted on the CEP page.

- Log into <u>schoolcafe.com</u>. (Users will need to sign into an existing School Cafe account or create a new one).
- After you log in, on the left side under 'Benefits', click 'Apply'.

Visitors and Raptor 6

All visitors to the school will be checked into the building in two ways:

- 1. All visitors will be required to use the Raptor 6 (this requires a valid driver's license/photo identification).
- All visitors' identification will be matched with our school information (as provided by the parent on the emergency contact card).

If individuals other than the parent/guardian are coming for lunch or to attend an event, we must receive a written note from the parent/guardian. If we do not receive a written note, the visitor will not be permitted to enter the building. if you know an individual is coming to have lunch at school or attend an event, it is important that:

- 1. The parent accompanies the visitor.
- 2. The parent provide written notification to the front office prior to the visit.

Student Safety



The safety and welfare of our students and staff are our highest priorities. To provide schools an opportunity to practice emergency response procedures, all students and staff will regularly participate in emergency preparedness drills. The goals of the training drill are to improve our ability to protect students and staff, evaluate our

emergency operations plan and improve our response skills. Tomorrow, we will be conducting emergency drills. If you arrive on campus during these drills, you will not be allowed entry, and phones will not be answered until after the drill has concluded.

Emergency procedures have been established for the following potential incidents:

EVACUATE (Fire, Explosion, Smell of Smoke, Fire Alarm)

LOCKDOWN (Intruder inside Building, Weapon, Active Shooter, Hostile Individual)

SECURE (Police Activity Outside or Near the Building – Secure the Perimeter)

HOLD (Safeguard students and staff inside the building)

SHELTER (Severe Weather, Tornado, High Winds, Hurricane)

Wednesday, September 6th, our students will be participating in the following drills:

EVACUATE LOCKDOWN

Our staff used the first few days of school to review the proper procedures for each of the crisis drills listed above. We want to provide our students with an understanding of emergency preparedness in the event of a crisis. Attendance

Your child's success is directly related to excellent attendance. Our

overall school attendance rate is an indicator on our state accountability rating and effects Warner's overall success. Students arriving after 8:15 a.m. are

tardy. Attendance is marked daily at 9:30 a.m. Students who are absent should submit a written excuse (parent note or doctor's excuse) upon returning to school or you may email it to Warner@cfisd.net. Excessive tardies/absences will

be referred to the district's truancy officer.
