District of Innovation



During the October 2023 board meeting, our board approved the district moving forward to develop a proposed District of Innovation (DOI) Plan. The board also approved the Districtwide Educational Improvement DOI Planning Committee.

Council (DEIC) to serve as the DOI Planning Committee.

The committee met once in October and twice in November. A proposed plan was developed and is now posted for review for 30 days on the CFISD website. The next step is for the DEIC to vote to approve (majority) or not approve the plan on December 14. If approved, the plan will be sent to the board in January 2024 for a vote (2/3 majority to approve.)
