Book Character Pumpkin Contest

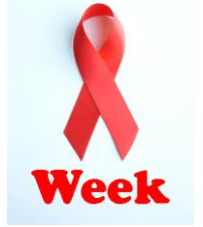

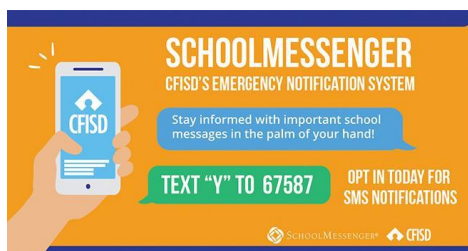
