## Book Character Pumpkin Contest

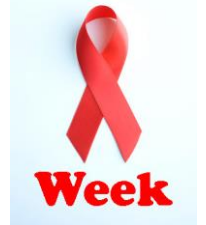

## Perfect Attendance



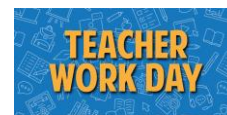
