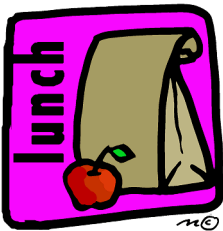

## Lunch Visitors



**Lunch Visitors begins Tuesday, September 12, 2023. Two (2) visitors per student one time per week will be allowed in for lunch. Reminder: only parents/guardians may visit for lunch at this time (no younger siblings).**

Parents/Guardians may bring food and beverages for their child, but they **may not** bring food/drinks for other children. Many parents/guardians treat their children to special lunches from outside restaurants occasionally. While we encourage you to reward your children with these special celebrations, we ask that if you are bringing your child lunch that you arrive on time. To protect instructional time, any student waiting on a parent/guardian ten minutes after lunch has begun will be sent through the cafeteria line.

## News from the Cafeteria



To determine eligibility for free or reduced-price meals for the 2023-2024 school year, families with students who do not attend a

Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) campus will need to complete a **Free & Reduced Meal Application**. Applications must be completed each school year to determine eligibility.

#### How to access the application in SchoolCafe Online.

- Log into [schoolcafe.com](http://schoolcafe.com). (Users will need to sign into an existing School Cafe account or create a new one).
- After you log in, on the left side under 'Benefits', click 'Apply'.



#### Visitors and Raptor 6

All visitors to the school will be checked into the building in two ways:

1. All visitors will be required to use the Raptor 6 (this requires a valid driver's license/photo identification).
2. All visitors' identification will be matched with our school information (as provided by the parent on the emergency contact card).

**If individuals other than the parent/guardian are coming for lunch or to attend an event, we must receive a written note from the parent/guardian. If we do not receive a written note, the visitor will not be permitted to enter the building.** If you know an individual is coming to have lunch at school or attend an event, it is important that:

1. The parent accompanies the visitor.
2. The parent provide written notification to the front office prior to the visit.

#### Football/Cheerleaders

Students may wear their football jersey to school on game days with a t-shirt underneath. Cheerleaders may wear their uniforms with leggings underneath (leggings to the knee or the calf).

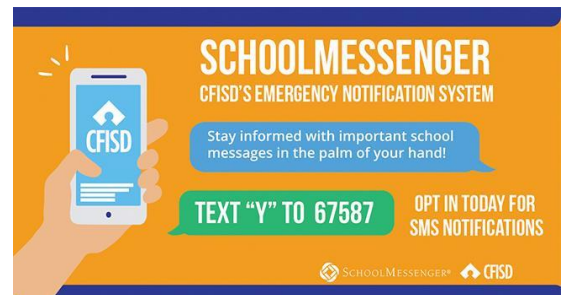
