BOOSTER THON

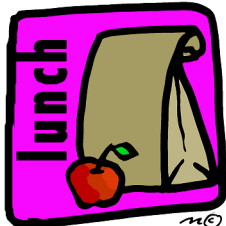

Lunch Visitors

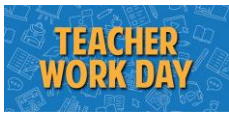
Spring Creek BBQ Spirit Night
