Welcome and Call to Order

Closed Session

Discussion Items

Campus Audit Summary

Mr. Hudson presented a summary of the state audits since the start back in September 2022.

- 73 campuses completed
- 45 Elementary Schools, 16 Middle Schools, 12 High Schools

- 40 Campuses have passed all phases of the audit
- 22 Corrective actions verified and approved
- 11 corrective actions needing submission

During the time period of April 14 through May 19:

- 20 campuses completed
- 9 campuses passed all phases of the audit
- 11 campuses with findings

Intruder Detection Audit Results & Corrective Action Plan

Mr. Hudson presented the findings of each of the twenty audited campuses.

Action Items

Consider adoption of the Intruder Detection Audit Corrective Action Plans

Once all the findings were presented and discussed, Mr. Hudson called for a motion to end the closed session. Daren Crawford initiated the motion, and Grant Burnett seconded. There was no further discussion and the positive vote was unanimous, the motion carried. Mr. Hudson requested that the livestream be restored to the open session.

Once out of closed session, Mr. Hudson welcomed back the viewing public. He requested a motion to adopt the corrective action plans as presented during the closed session. Lynn Blakeslee initiated the motion, and Wes Baker seconded. There was no further discussion and the motion carried.

Mr. Hudson explained that the Board of Trustees will be provided a report of the Intruder Detection Audit Findings and the Corrective Action Plans. He further explained that the Corrective Action Plans would be submitted to the Texas School Safety Commission before the respective deadlines.
