## Hello parents and guardians:

Cypress Fairbanks I.S.D. bus transportation will be provided for ALL Horne Elementary students attending their home campus as established by the district's 2023-2024 attendance boundaries.

ALL Horne Elementary students may receive transportation to one eligible pick-up address and one eligible take home address within their attendance boundary at the following eligible locations:

- 1. The student's primary residence.
- 2. A state recognized childcare provider (including state recognized in-home care providers).
- 3. A grandparent responsible for providing before and after school care for the student.

Except for high school boundary sibling transfers, transportation is not provided for transfer students to/from the student's primary residence. Transfer students may be transported to/from a state recognized childcare provider, parent, or grandparent responsible for providing before and after school care if there is a district-approved stop on a district-approved route serving the transfer campus. Questions about your transfer student's eligibility for transportation may be directed to Student Services/Admissions at StudentTransfers@cfisd.net.

Select and review 'what bus do I ride' at which time you may register for the TRAVERSA RIDE 360 app, a mobile application that will allow guardians to find information for their specific child including their bus stop along with the ability to track their specific bus and view when their child scans on and off the bus.

Your child's route number will be on the black signs on the sides and rear of the bus. Always refer to this number. Vehicles are subject to change so do not use the vehicle number on the bumper of the bus as the identifier for your child's route.

Here are safety precautions you will need to be aware of before your child rides the bus:

- For safety reasons, district bus service on a regular basis to and/or from different locations on different days is not allowed.
- Students are only allowed to ride their assigned bus to/from their designated bus stop. Any change in that assignment can only be made on an <u>emergency basis</u> if a request is submitted by the parent in writing and it is approved by school personnel or designee. Requests for transportation to after-school activities, such as sports and scouts, cannot be approved.
- Pre-kindergarten and kindergarten students are to be escorted from the school bus by a
  parent, guardian, or older sibling. If no one is available to escort the student, the student will be
  returned to his/her campus.
- Bus stops for riders meeting safety and efficiency standards are established by Transportation professionals for each grade level. Stops are located at corners for elementary students and may be at common centralized locations such as parks or community centers for middle and high school students.

- For safety reasons, students and parents should arrive at the bus stop 5-10 minutes prior to their scheduled pick-up time but not sooner. Students who are waiting at bus stops shall not loiter, trespass, litter, or create nuisance conditions for residents of the community.
- To promote a safe and pleasant ride for students, video cameras may be utilized. All students
  are expected to adhere to the <u>Bus Safety Rules</u> when being transported by buses or
  vehicles owned, operated, or controlled by the district.
- Please advise your child that he/she must properly wear seatbelts while being transported in any seat belt equipped vehicle that is owned, leased, or utilized by the district.
- All CFISD students will receive an identification card. ID's will be required each time the student
  enters and exits an assigned bus. It is the student's responsibility to have their ID card in their
  possession and to report any malfunction to their campus staff as soon as possible. By
  accessing the TRAVERSA RIDE 360 app, parents may know instantly where and when
  your child enters and exits the bus as well as the bus location.
- While visiting <a href="www.cfisd.net/Transportation">www.cfisd.net/Transportation</a>, please review the Transportation Safety Guidelines. We ask that you reinforce these communicated safety standards with your child make your child's ride to/from school safe and expeditious.

Parents, guardians, and persons acting in loco parentis will:

- 1. Be responsible and accountable for the conduct and safety of their children at all times prior to the arrival and after the departure of the school bus at the assigned school bus stop.
- 2. Understand and support district guidelines, policies, and regulations of school bus safety.
- 3. Assist students in understanding safety rules and encourage them.
- 4. Be cognizant of their own responsibilities for the actions of their children.

Understanding this, parents or guardians shall always be responsible and accountable for the conduct and safety of their children prior to the arrival and after the departure of the school bus at the assigned school bus stop. Transportation safety and service may be jeopardized by student non-compliance.

- For the first few weeks of school a range of factors may contribute to delays (traffic adjusting to the buses, student seat assignments, potential overcrowding, route direction adjustments, and delays at our campuses to ensure every student is loaded onto the correct bus for their take home route.) Realizing this can be frustrating when your child arrives home later than expected, please understand this is a 'transition time' for students and district staff. Therefore, we appreciate your patience in advance.
