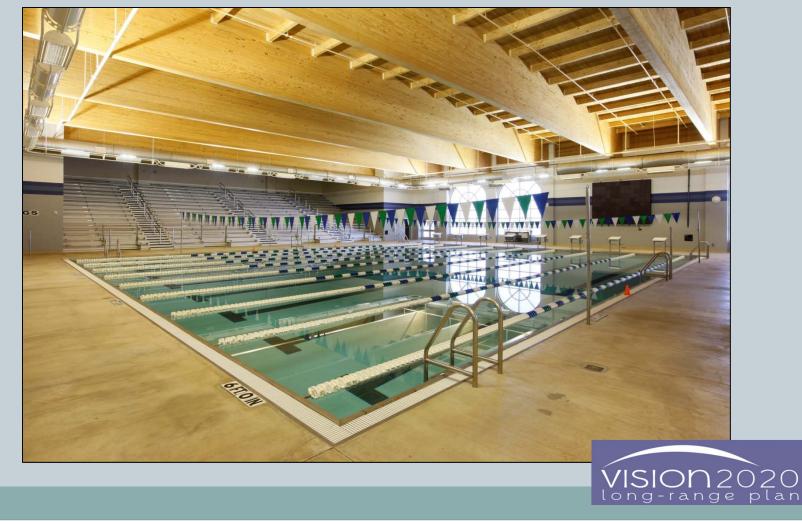

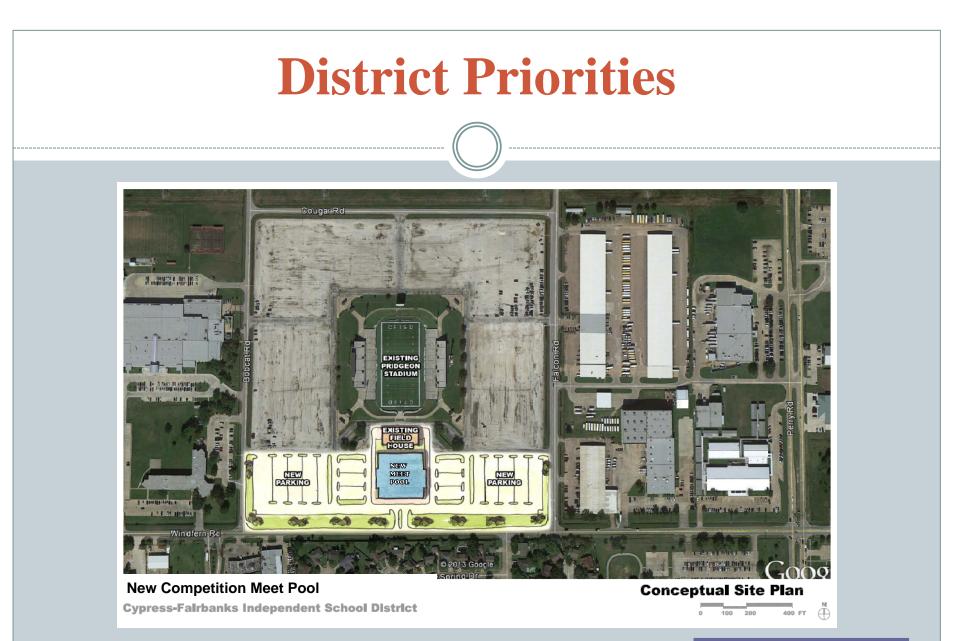

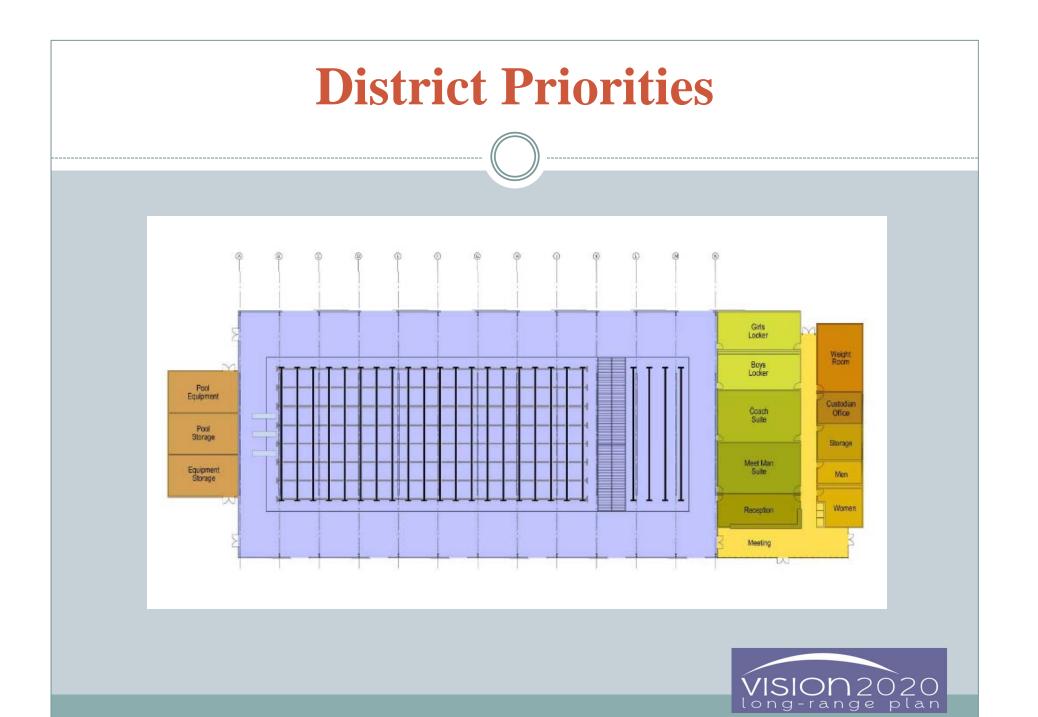

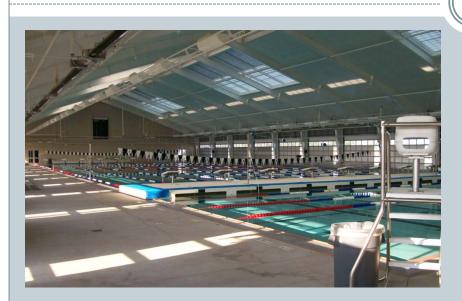

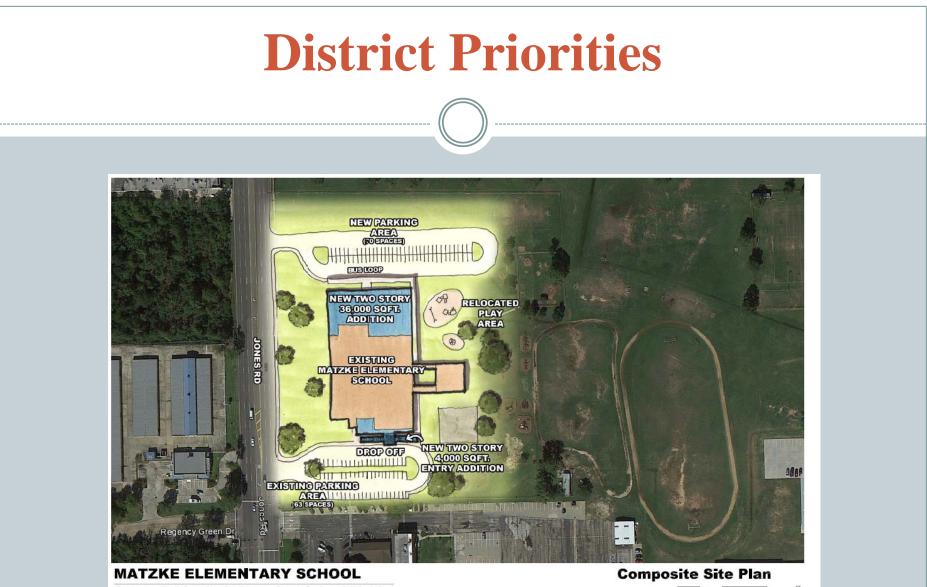

3	Would Like to Do: Curricular, Instructional, and Program Enhancement - (Life Expectancy: 6 - 10 years)

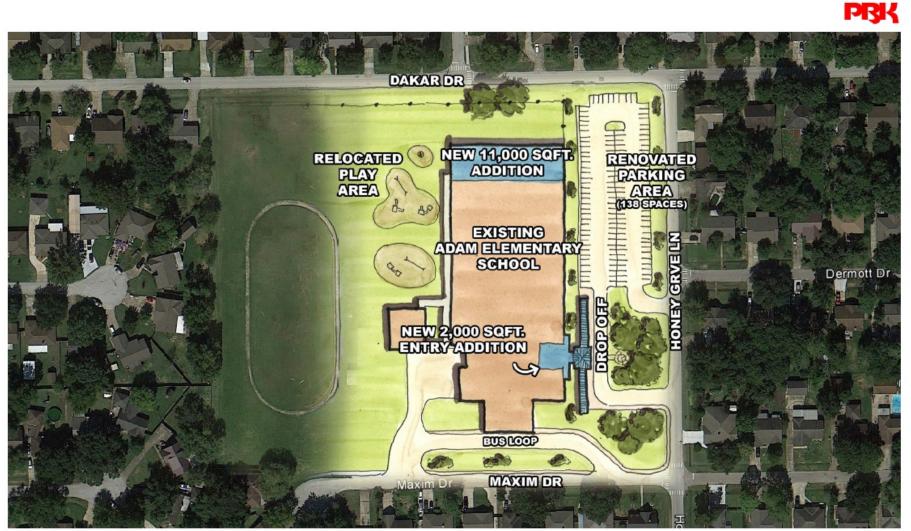

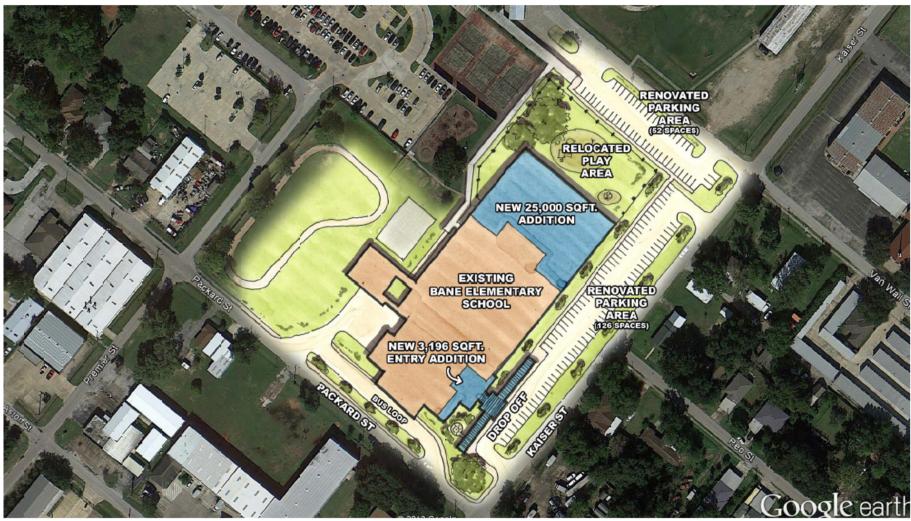

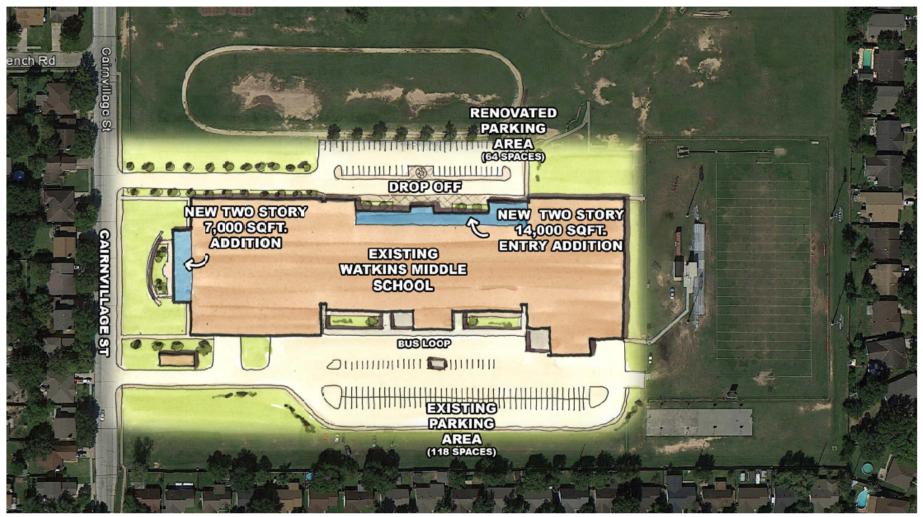

Facilities Conditions Index

- The facility condition index (FCI) is used in to provide a benchmark to compare the relative condition of a group of facilities.
- The facility in question is benchmarked against its replacement cost.
- The FCI is calculated:
 - Facility Repair Cost / Facility Replacement Value



Facilities Conditions Index

• Facility Condition Index Chart

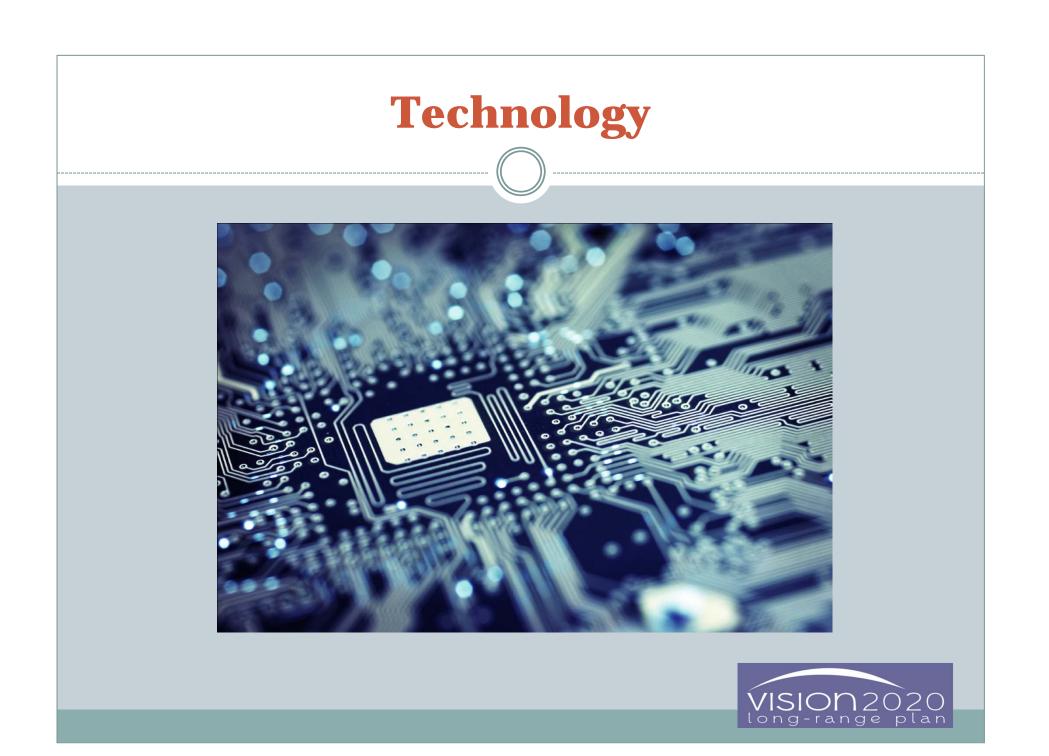
FCI Number	Building Condition
10% or less	Excellent
11% - 30%	Very Good
31% - 45%	Good
46% - 50%	Average
51% or more	Poor
