

How to Apply to a Community College

Community colleges are open-enrollment. Anyone can attend! Follow the steps below:

1. Select a school that has your program/area of interest and visit their website. If attending Lone Star College, you will need to complete the enrollment guide and online application at www.lonestar.edu.
2. Take required placement test (TSI or THEA) at the college. Lone Star College requires the TSI test. This is a computerized test with 4 sections: math, reading, writing, and grammar. Contact the testing center for information about how and when you can test. You can test at any branch, regardless of where you plan to take classes. The test costs \$29. They require you to arrive at least 4 hours prior to closing and you must bring a photo ID.
3. Register for classes by the first class day. Classes will get full fast, so check the website to find out when registration is open. Registration for summer and fall classes typically opens in March. Classes can be found at www.lonestar.edu. Go to "Programs & Classes", then "Class Search." Go to "Show all Classes," then start browsing!
