Who is eligible?

Juniors and Seniors who wish to take one or two courses in certain programs of study **beyond the requirements for graduation.** 😊

The course must be the third or fourth course in the sequence within the program of study; and the course must be listed on our 2023-2024 Pass/Fail Course list.



How many courses can you pass/fail?

- ❖ You may take only 1 credit on a pass/fail basis during your junior year and 1 credit during your senior year.
- ❖ Seniors may take two credits pass/fail if *you did not take one your junior year. All courses must be on the Pass/Fail course list.*



How are grades handled in the P/F course?

- You will receive a numerical grade all year on the report card; and
 - you will receive a P (Pass) or F (Fail) on the transcript.
 - **NCAA athletes---Please check the NCAA Clearinghouse for pass/fail implications.**



Pass/Fail Process:

Juniors and Seniors who wish to apply 😊

- **Step 1:** Verify that the class you're planning to pass/fail is the third or fourth course in the sequence, and that it's included on the Pass/Fail Course List. *For yearlong P/F classes, you must reapply in the Spring.*
- **Step 2:** If the course is on the list, scan the QR code for the P/F Application if you are choosing to apply. *(See the QR code on slide 11)*
- **Step 3:** Submit the Google P/F Application by *Monday, January 22nd by 3:00 pm.*



Courses Allowed on a Pass/Fail Basis

Cypress-Fairbanks I.S.D. wants to encourage students to pursue their areas of special talents and aptitudes and to enrich their academic achievement through efforts both in and out of the public school setting. Academically-able and talented students frequently forfeit opportunities to study in their areas of talent and interest. To encourage these students to explore areas of interest in depth while they are in high school, the district is offering the following courses to students in grades 11 and 12 on a pass/fail basis. To qualify to take a course for pass/fail, the student must have completed two L-level credits in the defined sequence/program of study.
