CFISD BO 2023

CFISD continues to accommodate growth with new campuses funded by the 2019 bond referendum. Our 58th elementary school, Brosnahan Elementary, opened near Clay and Fry roads in August. We also opened our 20th middle school, Sprague Middle School, which is part of the multi-campus educational village with Bridgeland High School and Wells Elementary School.

Jarvis Transportation Center

The impressive Visual and Performing Arts Center will open in the 2023-2024 school year near Cy-Fair High School, on the site of the new Mark Henry, Ed.D. Administration Building that opened in 2022-2023.

Sprague Middle School

Our sixth transportation center, the Jarvis Transportation Center, opened near Spillane Middle School over the summer, and will alleviate bus routes while housing a first-of-its-kind training center for drivers to hone their craft.

Bond funds also enabled the district to revitalize and secure existing campuses. CFISD devoted \$141.923 million to 18 summer renovation projects in 2023.

> CFISD will complete the final phase of baseball and softball facility upgrades including turf field replacement at all 12 high schools this fall with new fields at Cy-Fair High School.

Elementary Renovations

The district's mental health intervention team (MHIT), comprised of four licensed professional counselors, two licensed psychologists and two mental health police officers, continues to provide a proactive, targeted, and safe approach to dealing with mental health issues in CFISD. Positive relationships between the counselors and students have been instrumental in deterring potential situations.

CFPD leadership continually evaluates and implements new safety initiatives, including the "Text a Tip" campaign-which allows district students, staff and community to text "CFISD" to 738477 in order to guickly reach the anonymous CFISD Tipline.

CFISD maintains its reputation of being a safety and security leader across the state and nation. In April, Navigate360 presented CFISD with a District Excellence in School Safety & Student Wellness designationone of only eight districts nationwide to earn this award.

Salety

Now in its 12th year, the CFISD police department has expanded to 116 fully commissioned, well-trained officers with four K-9s that specialize in narcotics and gunpowder / explosives detection. The Ben Bradley Police Headquarters is currently undergoing expansion that will conclude this school year.

Due to the bond, classroom phones are now in every classroom districtwide, and a police vehicle replacement schedule is two-thirds complete.

The 2019 bond program dedicated \$207.6 million to even more safety and security enhancements, including:

- Segmentation of open-concept floor plans in elementary schools;
- Fencing around portable buildings and playgrounds;
- Impact-resistant glass on doors and high-traffic areas;
- Secure vestibule enhancements:
- Replacement of classroom door hardware;
- Addition of door prop alarms; and
- Additional lockdown buttons and card reader access locks.


TECHNOLOGY

More than \$238 million from CFISD's 2019 bond package was devoted to technology.

The first phase of CFISD's LTE 1:1 program successfully delivered more than 115,000 Chromebooks to every student. The second phase of the project is now underway, replacing approximately 40,000 aging laptops that were already in the district prior to the start of the 1:1 program.

Teacher laptops and Promethean panels are also undergoing replacements as a result of the bond.

Lightspeed audio enhancement systems have been replaced districtwide in elementary and middle school campuses, with high school replacements scheduled to start in the fall of 2023. Students are hearing their teachers more clearly, enhancing their ability to learn!



COMMUNITY Relations

The 10th annual Superintendent's Fun Run shattered previous fundraising marks for the Cy-Fair Educational Foundation, generating \$210,000 in a fun community event that has become a community tradition each year. After additional donations, the Fun Run eclipsed more than \$1 million raised

Business and faith-based partners give back to the school district in many ways, including "Adopt-a-School partnerships" that pair an organization with a campus and provide resources and support. CFISD created 21 new Adopt-a-School partnerships in 2022-2023
