Intruder Detection Audit Results & Corrective Action Plan

Mr. Hudson presented an audit summary illustrating that from October 2023 through February 2024, 58 of 92 campuses had been visited. This included 36 of 58 elementary schools, 12 of 20 middle schools, and 10 of 14 High Schools. Of the 34 Campuses audited from December through February, 32 passed all phases of the audit.

Action Items

Consider adoption of the Intruder Detection Audit Corrective Action Plans

Once all the findings were presented and discussed, Mr. Hudson called for a motion to end the closed session. Daren Crawford initiated the motion, and Don Cornman seconded.
