

CFISD Practicum in Architectural Design

Scope and Sequence

Course Description:

An occupationally specific course designed to provide technical instruction in architectural design. Instruction may be delivered through an unpaid laboratory training or through paid career preparation delivery arrangements. Students are required to work 10 hours per week at an approved training site and must be employed at that site within 15 school days after enrollment in the course. (2 Credits)

- Required prerequisite: Architectural Design I, Architectural Design II and age 16 if paid training site
