Course Description:

This one-semester art course includes the fundamentals of design, drawing, painting, printmaking, and sculpture. Students will learn about art materials, concepts, and vocabulary, and will develop the skills necessary for communicating ideas and emotions through art. Emphasis is placed on problem-solving and application of skills to enhance originality, creativity, and craftsmanship.

If pre-assessment indicates student mastery could be achieved in a fewer number of days, the additional time could be used for extension or carried into the next unit.
