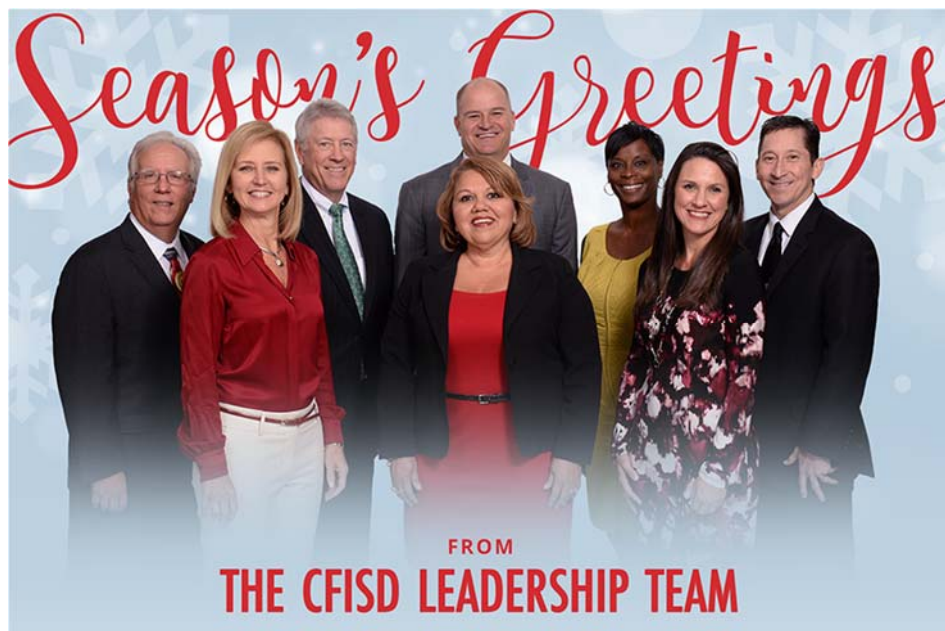
Dear CFISD community,
