

## CFISD Practicum in Human Services

### Scope and Sequence

**Course Description:**

This course, formerly ECP II, continues the emphasis of laboratory experiences in a preschool setting. In the Practicum in Human Services, students mentor the Child Guidance (ECP I) students and continue participating in extended learning/teaching experiences with the three and four year old children in the preschools located in the high schools. They model ethical behaviors, comply with laws and regulations, and assist in establishing a physically and psychologically healthy environment to inspire client confidence in services provided. The students are expected to produce a professional portfolio. (2 Credits)
