

CFISD Cosmetology II & Principles of Cosmetology Design & Color Theory Scope and Sequence

Course Description:

This course provides the final advanced training for employment in cosmetology careers (see list of trainings in the description of the Intro course). The course meets the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation requirements for licensure upon completing the required 1000 clock hours of licensed instructor monitoring student classroom instruction/application and a passing grade on the state examination. Good attendance is necessary to be successful in this lucrative career path training. (3 credits)

- ◆ Grades 11 and 12
- ◆ Required prerequisite: Introduction to Cosmetology and Cosmetology I
- ◆ Lab/kit/uniform supplies or fee may be required.
- ◆ Assessment for verification of industry-recognized training is available for a fee
- ◆ Must be taken concurrently with Principles of Cosmetology Design and Color Theory
