Scope and Sequence 2019-2020

Course Description: Texas history emphasizes the multi-cultural perspective of the state’s history, including contributions by Native Americans, Europeans, Anglos, and other non-English speaking cultures. Students will study the history of Texas by exploring historical eras. Students also study the structure and functions of municipal, county, and state governments; explain the influence of the U.S. Constitution on the Texas Constitution; and examine the rights and responsibilities of Texas citizens. HORIZONS students focus on the same units of study as on-level students; however, the curriculum is compressed and accelerated within each grading period giving students an opportunity to experience culminating activities. These activities allow students to investigate subject matter at a deeper and more complex level.
